Reminders from the Oradell Department of Public Works

Scheduled **Leaf pick up** will run from the week of October 12th to the Week of December 14th

Starting the week of December 21st, the crews will do **one last final pick up** starting in Section 1.

During Leaf Season leaves should be placed at the curb no earlier than the weekend **prior** to your scheduled pickup. See schedule for your scheduled week.

To better serve you, the following is needed to facilitate the pick-up of leaves.....

- NO PLASTIC BAGS, GARBAGE CANS OR BOXES OF ANY KIND will be collected
- Pile leaves neatly at the curb so as NOT to obstruct traffic in the street
- Do NOT mix debris with leaves such as rocks, wood, branches, twigs, etc. (only grass clippings & leaves will be collected)
- Branches must be dropped off to the Recycling Center
- Leaves should NOT be piled around fire hydrants, light poles, signs, trees, etc.
- Leaves should NOT be placed closer than fifteen (15) feet to a stop sign
- DO NOT place leaves within ten (10) feet of either side of a storm drain or on top of it
- DO NOT place leaves prior to your scheduled collection week
- Vehicles parked in the street prevent us from working along the curb and collecting your leaves
- If you have a landscape contractor please inform them of the above-mentioned items

STYROFOAM


Expanded Poly Styrene (EPS) is now accepted: rigid white packing type foam, no food containers. Bring only EPS Styrofoam to the designated container at the DPW. It is sent to a recycler where it is melted and condensed for other uses keeping it out of our waste stream.

ELECTION INFORMATION

GENERAL ELECTION

is being conducted only by mail-in ballots.

However, each municipality will have 1 polling location strictly for voters who are blind, physically disabled or illiterate. Any voter wanting to use the voting machine must fill out a Disability Certificate for Assistance.

Polling Location:

River Dell HS (new gym)

6:00am – 8:00pm

Must wear a face mask & observe social distancing

** October 13, 2020 is the last day to register to vote **

All active registered voters will *automatically* receive a mail-in ballot.

Mail-in Ballots can either be mailed by regular mail or deposited in one of the 18 Drop Boxes located throughout the County. All ballot drop boxes are available 24hrs a day and will have surveillance cameras.
