
The Oradell Mayor and Council and the Oradell Police Department are happy to announce that the Oradell-Emerson Rotary Club has partnered with the borough to sponsor our downtown pedestrian safety flag program. Pedestrian safety flags have been installed by our Department of Public Works at seven different crosswalks on Kinderkamack Road and Oradell Avenue. The Mayor and Council, Oradell Police Department and the Rotary are committed to pedestrian safety and to raising awareness and heightening the visibility of our pedestrian traffic while they walk around our downtown. Pedestrians are encouraged to grab an orange flag from one of the buckets to make themselves more visible. Once traffic has stopped, the pedestrian can cross in the crosswalk safely and then place the flag in the bucket on the other side of the crosswalk. We ask that pedestrians always remember to cross only after traffic has come to a complete stop. We hope the flags will grab the attention of drivers so they can safely bring their vehicle to a stop before the pedestrian crosses the roadway.
