

RESOLUTION #15-205
BOROUGH OF ORADELL
COUNTY OF BERGEN

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oradell has taken measures in the past few years to provide a safe environment on Prospect Avenue on Halloween;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council continue to recognize the need to maintain a safe environment for residents in mass number who engage in trick or treating activities along Prospect Avenue between Oradell Avenue and Soldier Hill Road.

WHEREAS, Halloween falls on a Saturday this year and does not necessitate the same measures as in prior years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Oradell hereby directs the Borough Administrator to coordinate and deploy Borough resources as required to ensure the public safety as follows;


1. The Borough Administrator is hereby directed to coordinate with all Borough Officials and professionals required to plan and execute any and all necessary safety precautions to provide for a safe environment on Prospect Avenue between Oradell Avenue and Soldier Hill Road on Halloween, Saturday October 31, 2015.
2. The Borough Administrator shall further request the Superintendent of Public Works remove all leaves and debris from all streets affected by this activity in advance of 10/31/15.
3. The Borough Administrator shall further request the Detective Sergeant to enact temporary "No Parking" restrictions on 10/31/15 from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM on both sides of Prospect Avenue between Oradell Avenue and Soldier Hill Road, further, the deployment of police message boards to be located (1 Each) on Prospect Avenue in the vicinity of Oradell Avenue and Soldier Hill Road a minimum of 72 Hours prior to 10/31/15 advising of such restrictions and providing other public safety messaging.
4. The Borough Administrator shall adequately communicate such temporary closures, restrictions, and any other Borough actions concerning this matter to all affected residents by way of but not limited to; Borough Website, Nixle, US Mail.
