IMPORTANT ELECTION INFORMATION PRIMARY ELECTION JULY 7, 2020

REMINDER: The July 7, 2020 Primary Election is "VOTE BY MAIL ONLY". Active registered Republicans and Democrats will automatically be sent a Primary Ballot. If you are registered with either political party affiliation and did not receive your ballot please call 201-336-7020 to have a duplicate one mailed to you. All active undeclared/unaffiliated and inactive republican and democrats will be sent an application to apply for a Primary Ballot. All ballots and applications for ballots have prepaid postage and instructions on them. Please send back ballots and applications through regular mail or you may drop them at the below ballot drop boxes.

IMPORTANT: Voting Machines will be strictly for voters who are blind or disabled. There will be one polling place to use : 2nd floor (elevator available) Borough Hall meeting room. 7 AM-8PM. Masks are required to enter the building. All other voters will be given a provisional ballot. Any voter wanting to use the voting machine must fill out a Disabled Certificate for Assistance. The poll worker then calls the Board of Elections to verify the voter HAS NOT send in their Vote By Mail Ballot. Only then can a disabled voter enter the book to cast a vote. Vote By Mail ballots postmarked by July 7th and received by July 14th will be counted.

Ballot drop Boxes can be found outside the following locations:

Demarest- 118 Serpentine Road Demarest NJ (Borough Hall)

Ridgewood-131 North Maple Avenue, Ridgewood NJ (Village Hall)

Hackensack- One Bergen County Plaza, Hackensack NJ (County Administration Building)

Fort Lee- 1355 Inwood Terrace/Anderson Avenue Circular Driveway (Fort Lee Community Center)

Ramsey- 30 Wyckoff Avenue (Library – rear of the building)

Rutherford- 176 Park Avenue, Rutherford (Borough Hall)

Ballot drop boxes are available 24-hours. Ballots must be in the drop by **8PM on Election Night**. Ballots left after 8PM on Election night will be considered late and not counted.
