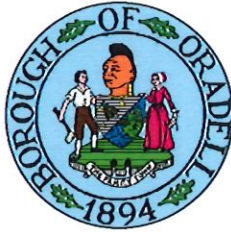

Minutes of the Meeting of the Oradell Board of Health November 8, 2021

The November 8, 2021 meeting of the Oradell Board of Health ("OBOH"), held via Zoom teleconferencing, was called to order by Mrs. Catherine Schmidt, Chairperson, at 8:00 pm.

PRESENT: Ms. Mary Battaglia, Dr. Kathleen Dicedue, Dr. Craig Froomjian, Mrs. Janet Schneider, Mrs. Catherine Schmidt, Mr. Jonathan Kern (Council Liaison), and Ms. Laura Folco (County Sanitarian).

ABSENT: Mrs. Nicole Alvarez and Mrs. Karen DePol.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion to approve the Minutes of the October 18, 2021 regular meeting of the OBOH was made by Dr. Froomjian, and seconded by Ms. Battaglia. Vote: All in favor; none opposed.

VERBAL COMMUNICATIONS:

Mrs. Schmidt reported that the OEM Task Force has not met since the prior OBOH meeting.

COUNCIL LIAISON REPORT:

- Councilman Kern commented on the tree ordinance currently being developed by the mayor and council. He also summarized recent discussions regarding flooding from Hurricane Ida and input from affected residents.

Sites were also given ongoing COVID-19 Compliance assistance/education by Sanitarian, e.g., masks, sanitizing, gloves, etc.

- No plans have been submitted yet for the new restaurant "Oak" (at the former Charlie Brown's site).

NURSING / MEDICAL REPORT:

Dr. Dickey reported:

- The number of cases of reportable diseases noted in the Health Consultation report is approximately the same seen in September: 41 cases. These cases include both COVID and Legionellosis.
- The Immunization report for transfers to River Dell High School showed full compliance.

FINANCE REPORT:

Mrs. Schmidt reported on revenue and expenses as of October 31, 2021:

- Revenue totaled \$128.00, sourced from Business Licenses (\$25), Dog Licenses (\$25), Transcripts (\$50), and Marriage Licenses (\$28).
- Expenses were \$5.40 for the State Dog Licensing Report.

The balance in the Animal Control Trust was \$10,171.88 at October 31, 2021.

OLD BUSINESS:

Members concluded discussions regarding a previously received complaint citing an older resident who was thought to need assistance. Subsequent inquiries show that the resident is indeed able to care for himself, i.e., interventions and/or Adult Protective Services are not needed.

NEW BUSINESS:

- None.

ADJOURNMENT:

Since there was no further business to be discussed, Ms. Battaglia made a motion to adjourn the November 8, 2021 meeting of the Oradell Board of Health at 8:33 pm; Dr. Dicedue seconded the motion.
