Bergen County Dept. of Health Services will be administering flu shots on Oct. 15th (11 am to noon) for Oradell residents who have Medicare Part B insurance and are aged 65 or older. October 27: Last day to apply for a Vote by Mail ballot by Mail.

November 2: Last day to apply in person at the County Clerk's Office (Room 130) for a Vote by Mail Ballot for the General Election.

ACH BANK DRAFT PROGRAM TO PAY PROPERTY TAXES

The Borough of Oradell Tax Collector's Office offers an ACH bank draft program (direct withdrawal) to our taxpayers. This service assures your payment will be received in a timely manner as well as providing a safe and secure way to pay your taxes without the worry of mail delivery or coming in to pay in person.

Quarterly property tax payments, as billed, will be debited from your CHECKING account on the payment due dates of February 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1. We do not draft from savings or equity accounts. You may enroll or cancel at any time, provided a completed authorization form is received **at least four weeks prior to the scheduled draft dates.**

If you would like to enroll in this program, please complete the **entire authorization form** which is available on the Borough's website. Be sure to attach a **voided check**. Incomplete applications will delay enrollment.

MAIL DROP-OFF BOX

For your convenience, a drop-off mail box is located in the rear of the Borough Hall for after hours for tax payments, letters to the Mayor and Council, etc.

2015 Leaf Pickup Schedule

Beginning in October you may place leaves curbside for pickup in accordance with the schedule printed below. We ask that you do not bag leaves and do not put leaves curbside after the final pickup. Please have your leaves curbside during the weekend prior to your pickup week. If you have a landscaper maintaining your property, please give them a copy of this schedule so they may clean your property prior to your leaf pickup. For everyone's benefit, the sections were rotated this year. The Department of Public Works will keep coming around until the entire Borough is cleaned up.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be no leaf collection on November 11, 26, 27 and December 25.

REMINDERS

FROM THE
ORADELL POLICE
DEPT.

With school back in session, the Oradell Police Dept. would like to remind everyone to be extra mindful of pedestrian traffic especially around our schools. Our borough crossing guards are back on their posts and it is imperative that while operating your motor vehicle you adhere to the crossing guard signals. The school crossing guards are under the supervision of the Police Department and complying with their signals will assist in keeping our children safe.

Daylight Savings Time is ending at 2 am on Sunday, November 1st. This not only means that you need to set your clocks back one hour but that it will get dark earlier. It's a good time to remember a few simple safety tips:

At home, keep a light on or adjust your timers so you will come home to a well-lighted house. Illuminate your home address to assist the police in locating your address.

Evening commute from work—stay alert to your surroundings, make sure your keys are readily accessible when approaching your vehicle, carry a small flashlight and park in well-lit areas.

FIRE SAFETY

As we prepare for the fall and the upcoming winter, now is a great time to have your home heating appliances, flues and chimneys checked, cleaned and have regular maintenance performed. Additionally, when using a fireplace, make sure a sturdy screen is in place. This will prevent any sparks from flying into a room. Only clean out a fireplace's ashes after they have cooled. Place the ashes in a metal container and move the container to a safe distance from your house. Don't forget to test your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors monthly.
