Conditions for Bonfires/Campfires

- 1. The permit shall be requested by and issued to the owner of the property where the event is to be held.
- 2. Completed applications shall be submitted no less than 10 days prior to the date of the fire being set.
- 3. Location of bonfire shall not be less than 50' from any structure/brush/shrubs/trees that may spread fire.
- 4. A site diagram shall be submitted with the permit application showing the location of bonfire in relation to the site with required dimensions (Diagram does not have to be to scale).
- 5. Material being burned shall consist only of seasoned dry firewood. No waste materials are permitted.
- 6. The bonfire shall be ignited by a small quantity of paper only.
- 7. THE USE OF FLAMMABLE OR COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS IS PROHIBITED.
- 8. Size of bonfire shall not exceed 5 feet by 5 feet by 5 feet, and shall not burn for more than 3 hours.
- 9. Provide a barrier to prevent access to bonfire, no less than 3o-foot radius to burning material.
- 10.Bonfire must be constantly attended by the Fire Department with the minimum of one charged 1 34" hose line in place for immediate use.
- 11.Bonfire must be attended until fire and coals are completely and thoroughly extinguished.
- 12. The location of the bonfire shall be inspected and approved by the Fire Official or his designee. Time of inspection to be determined by the Fire Official.
- 13. The permit may be revoked or the bonfire ordered extinguished at any time if the Fire Official feels that in his opinion there is a hazardous condition that may endanger the safety of the general public or any structure.
