## **Conditions for Open Burning Permit**

- 1. The permit shall be requested by and issued to the owner of the property where the burning is to be held.
- 2. Completed applications shall be submitted no less than 10 days prior to the date of the fire being set.
- 3. Location of open burning shall be no less than 50' from any structure/brush/shrubs/trees that may spread fire. A 15' separation is permitted if fire is maintained in an approved container.
- 4. A site diagram shall be submitted with the permit application showing the location of fire in relation to the site with required dimensions (Diagram does not have to be to scale).
- 5. Material being burned shall consist only of materials that will minimize the generation and emission of air contaminants. No waste materials are permitted.
- 6. Containers utilized for the burning of materials shall have a screen cover to prevent the escape of embers and/or sparks.
- 7. At all times during any burning at least one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 4-A or two extinguishers with a 2-A rating, or other approved on-site fire extinguishing equipment (garden hose, dirt, water truck) shall be maintained available for immediate use.
- 8. The permit may be revoked or the fire ordered extinguished at any time if the Fire Marshal or his designee feels that there is a hazardous condition that may endanger the safety of the general public, any structure or create an objectionable situation.
