## Conditions for Torch/Flame-producing Device Permits

- 1. The permit shall be requested by and issued to the owner of the property or party responsible for the work.
- 2. Completed applications shall be submitted no less than 10 days prior to the date of the event.
- Provide at least one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 4-A rating, or two portable fire extinguishers with a minimum 2-A rating each, or a water hose connected to the water supply on the premises where such burning is being performed.
- 4. In all cases, the person doing the burning shall remain on premises, to perform a fire watch, one (1) hour after the torch or flame-producing device is utilized.
- 5. If LPG cylinders are used to fuel the operation, all cylinders shall be properly secured to prevent falling, being knocked over and protected from tampering.
- 6. The storage of LPG cylinders on roof tops shall be prohibited.

## Asphalt (tar) kettles:

- 7. A kettle, when in operation, shall be placed a safe distance away from any structure or combustible material. Every kettle shall be equipped with a tight-fitting cover.
- 8. Asphalt (tar) kettles shall not be utilized inside or on the roof of any structure. Fired asphalt (tar) kettles shall not be left unattended.
- 9. There shall be at least one portable fire extinguisher with a minimum 20-B:C rating within 30 feet of each kettle when the kettle is in use, and an additional fire extinguisher with a minimum of 20-B:C rating on the roof being covered.

A permit may be revoked or the operation ordered stopped at any time if the Fire Official feels that in his opinion there is a hazardous condition that may endanger the safety of the general public, any structure or violate any condition of the permit under the NJUFC.
