Library Budget 2023 – Annual and scheduled increases

Resolution calling for salary increases effective January 1, 2023 in the amount of 4% or with a minimum of \$15/hour, whichever is higher and excluding employees hired since January 1, 2023; and the increase will be paid retroactively from January 1 to the current payroll period in order to bring all employees up to the appropriate total compensation for the year. In any case, any employee with pay below \$15/hour will be increased to \$15/hour. **EG | CG**
