WHEREAS, following the denial of the Grievance by the Borough and in accordance with the terms of the collective bargaining agreement, the Oradell PBA Local 206 filed a request for submission of a panel of arbitrators before the State of New Jersey Public Employment Relations Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Grievance was assigned Docket Number AR-2022-343 on February 2, 2022 and arbitration was scheduled to take place on October 13, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties have met to discuss the Grievance and a settlement of the Grievance as set forth in the attached settlement agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough's labor counsel, Deena B. Rosendahl, Esq., has reviewed the terms of settlement and has recommended the Borough settle the matter with the payment of three and a half (3.5) days to Sergeant Kevin Doyle as set forth in the attached Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Borough to settle the matter and authorize the Mayor to sign the Settlement Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body authorizes the settlement of the Grievance filed under Docket Number AR-2022-343 according to the terms set forth on the attached Settlement Agreement and

The law supplements existing law on the use of such contracts and is intended to provide additional flexibility to local government in the area of

Whereas, the Borough of Oradell has the need on a timely basis to purchase goods or services utilizing ESCNJ; and

Whereas, the Borough of Oradell intends to enter into contracts with the attached Referenced ESCNJ Vendors through this resolution and properly executed contracts, which shall be subject to all the conditions applicable to the Sourcewell contracts;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Borough of Oradell authorizes the Purchasing Agent to purchase certain goods or services from those approved ESCNJ Contract Vendors on the attached list, pursuant to all conditions of the individual Sourcewell contracts; and
