**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
BOROUGH OF ORADELL AND THE BOROUGH OF HASBROUCK HEIGHTS FOR THE USE
OF THE HASBROUCK HEIGHTS POLICE FIRING RANGE FOR 2026 FIREARMS TRAINING
AND QUALIFICATION**

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes municipalities to enter into agreements for the provision of shared services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Oradell Police Department is required to conduct periodic firearms training and qualifications in accordance with the New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines and the New Jersey State Police Firearms Training and Qualification Standards; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights maintains a police firing range suitable for law enforcement firearms training and qualification purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Oradell Police Department will utilize the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights outdoor police firing range for rifle training, qualification, and tactical shooting exercises when such training cannot be accommodated at the Park Ridge Police Department firing range; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights has agreed to permit the Borough of Oradell Police Department to utilize its police firing range for firearms training and certifications during **calendar year 2026**; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed upon a total cost of Five Hundred Dollars (**\$500.00**) for such use for the 2026 calendar year; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds are available for this purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights and the Borough of Oradell Chief Financial Officer.
