WHEREAS, the Bergen County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, Farmland & Historic Preservation Trust Fund ("County Trust Fund"), provides matching grants to municipal governments and to nonprofit organizations for assistance in the development or redevelopment of outdoor municipal recreation facilities; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Oradell:

- 1. That it is hereby authorized to submit the above completed project application to the County by the deadline of May 6, 2022, as established by the County; and,
- 2. That, in the event of a County Trust Fund award that may be less than the grant amount requested above, Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Oradell have, or will secure, the balance of funding necessary to complete the project, or modify the project as necessary; and,
- 3. That Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Oradell are committed to providing a dollar for dollar cash match for the project; and,
- 4. That only those park improvements identified and approved in the project application, its Trust Fund contract, or other documentation will be considered eligible for reimbursement.
