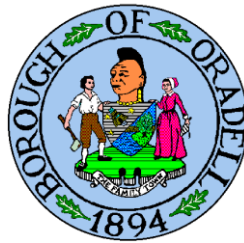


BOROUGH OF ORADELL BOARD OF HEALTH

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Minutes of the Meeting of the Oradell Board of Health February 12, 2018

The February 12, 2018 meeting of the Oradell Board of Health ("OBOH") was called to order by Mrs. Catherine Yaxley-Schmidt, Chairperson, at 8:06 pm.

Ms. Nassor and members discussed the month’s inspections. There were no critical issues.

PUBLICITY REPORT:

- None.

CODE & ORDINANCE:

- Mrs. Djurdjinovic, Vice Chair of the OBOH, read *Health Ordinance No. 18-01, “Regulation of Body Art Establishments within the Borough of Oradell,”* by title only.
- Mrs. Schmidt asked members, and then attendees, if they would like further discussion of the ordinance; there were no requests. Mrs. Schmidt noted that Ordinance No. 18-01 had been passed on first meeting by the OBOH at its January 8, 2018 meeting and was published in the Ridgewood News. Further, three signed copies were kept in the Borough’s Health Office for review by the public.
- A MOTION that *Health Ordinance No. 18-01, “Regulation of Body Art Establishments within the Borough of Oradell,”* be passed on second reading and be published in the Ridgewood News, was made by Dr. Dicie due, and seconded by Ms. DePol.

NURSING / MEDICAL REPORT:

- Dr. Dicedue reviewed the NJDOH Annual Immunization Status Report for each of Oradell Public School, River Dell High School, and the Reformed Church Nursery School; no significant issues were noted.
- She also noted four findings of reportable diseases, *Campylobacteriosis (C.jejuni)*, Influenza, and Lyme, from the December Health Consultation Program; and seven instances, including Hepatitis C, Influenza and Lyme Disease among patients attending the January clinic.

FINANCE REPORT:

Mrs. Schmidt reported on revenue and expenses as of January 31, 2018:

- The Trust balance is \$17,531.22.
- Expenses (NJ State Dog Licensing Report) totaled \$3.60.
- Revenue totaled \$6,822.40, provided by Dog/Cat licenses (\$2,834.40), Transcripts (\$1,120.00), Business licenses (\$2,865.00) and Marriage licenses (\$3.00).

OLD BUSINESS:

- Members briefly discussed January's beekeeping issue and the testimony provided by Mr. and Mrs. McGivern regarding the NJ Department of Agriculture's proposed amendments to beekeeping regulations. The OBOH opposed aspects of the draft regulations and documented this in a letter to the Mayor/Council, as requested by Mayor Didio.
- Mrs. Schmidt reported that she has not yet received an answer to her November 14, 2017 email to Mr. Oddo (the Borough Attorney) regarding the OBOH's interest in prohibiting sales of recreational marijuana within the Borough. She will bring a sample ordinance from another municipality to the March meeting for member review and discussion.
- Dr. Dicedue provided the members with a fact sheet on vaping, juuling (which refers to the use of a very small, flavored vaporizer able to be charged via a laptop USB port), and e-cigarettes. As previously noted, such devices (termed "ESDs") carry the false impression that they are safe. It was noted that the cartridges may be filled with Nicotine and other chemicals, in some instances including Formaldehyde, which can cause harm to a young person's developing brain, affecting both memory and attention, and Diacetyl, which can cause a lung disease known as "popcorn lung." Members would like to augment the Borough's existing smoking ordinance to include vaping, juuling and e-cigarettes.

NEW BUSINESS:

- None.

ADJOURNMENT:

Since there was no further business to be discussed, Ms. DePol moved that the February 12, 2018 meeting of the Oradell Board of Health be adjourned at 8:40 pm; motion seconded by Ms. Viscardi. Voting: all in favor, none opposed. The next regular meeting will be March 12, 2018 at 8:00 pm.
