Council Updates:

<u>Tracy Schoenberg</u> – Councilwoman Schoenberg asked for update on plexiglass and when borough hall will open to public by appointment only. Mrs. Lyons indicated as soon as they are received, they will be installed. She stated more information will be forthcoming for Seniors. The Borough is working on a covid plan for Senior Van transportation. She announced the Fire Truck up for auction was sold and the squad is back to normal schedule.

<u>Roger Tashjian</u> — Councilman Tashjian asked for an update from the Borough Engineer. David Atkinson stated there was a Pre-Con last week for the 2020 Road Program. Councilman Carnevale asked for an update regarding the Memorial Project.

Councilman Carnevale stated crews have been working hard to remove the trees effected by the Ash borer. Approximately 20 ash trees have been removed.

<u>Stephen Carnevale</u> – Councilman Carnevale stated the Oradell PD assisted with the graduation rive up ceremonies for OPS & RDHS. He also indicated OPD will be assisting River Dell High School will be having their in-person Outdoor Graduation on July 8 & Bergen Catholic on July 29. He reported that Planning Board and the Historical Committee haven't met since February.

<u>Robert Jannicelli-</u> Councilman Jannicelli reported the Recreation Committee met with League Presidents and the Covid Task Force to speak about a safe plan & guidance on opening fields. A "COVID Protocol" was developed for each team to submit and then be approved by the task force.

<u>Thomas Kelly</u> — Councilman Kelly reported the Borough is under 2% cap for 2020. A budget break down will be put in the Newsletter. There were no applications and no meeting scheduled for the Zoning Board. He requested again, that the swap shop re-opening be considered by the Task Force. He reported that the Farmers Market opening went smoothly.

<u>Miriam Yu</u> – Councilman Yu stated that the Board of Health met on June 8th and the Bergen County Health consulted has been cancelled until further notice. Mrs. Yu also provided the process on how library books are to be reserved.

<u>Laura Lyons -Admin/ Clerk – Mrs.</u> Lyons stated she and the Deputy Clerk will be participating in a conference call with Bergen County regarding upcoming Elections. She announced that the Recreation Summer Camp this summer has cancelled because of protocols & requirements that were put in place by the Health Dept & Governor's Office. She stated Fourth of July Festivities including the Fireworks have also been cancelled. We are working with the vendor to see about having them at a different time. The Borough is looking to host two Drive-In Movies events. We are also The Borough is working getting the Basketball Hoops up and DPAC back up soon as well.
