Reminder from the Dept of Public Works -

Scheduled Leaf pick up will run from the Week of October 12th to the Week of December 14th

Starting the week of December 21st, the crews will do **one last pick up** starting in Section 1.

During Leaf Season leaves should be placed at the curb no earlier than the weekend <u>prior</u> to your scheduled pickup. <u>See schedule for your scheduled week.</u>

To better serve you, the following is needed to facilitate the pick-up of leaves.....

- •NO PLASTIC BAGS, GARBAGE CANS OR BOXES OF ANY KIND will be collected
- •Pile leaves neatly at the curb so as NOT to obstruct traffic in the street
- •Do NOT mix debris with leaves such as rocks, wood, branches, twigs, etc. (only grass clippings & leaves will be collected)
- •Branches must be dropped off to the Recycling Center
- •Leaves should NOT be piled around fire hydrants, light poles, signs, trees, etc.
- •Leaves should NOT be placed closer than fifteen (15) feet to a stop sign
- •DO NOT place leaves within ten (10) feet of either side of a storm drain or on top of it
- •DO NOT place leaves prior to your scheduled collection week
- •Vehicles parked in the street prevent us from working along the curb and collecting your leaves
- •If you have a landscape contractor please inform them of the above-mentioned items
